## WESTTOWN TOWNSHIP'S OAKBOURNE MANSION

Oakbourne Mansion, located in the heart of Westtown Township, is a large Victorian building that originated as a residence in the late 19th Century. It was built by Mr. And Mrs. John Hulme, who used it as a summer home for several years. In 1882, Mr. and Mrs. James Smith purchased the Mansion and surrounding grounds. They enlarged the building and developed the grounds into an arboretum and horse breeding operation. After Mrs. Smith's death in 1893, the property was willed to the Philadelphia Protestant Episcopal City Mission. At this time, it was used as a convalescent home for women. The Westtown Township purchased the Mansion and surrounding grounds some seventy years later.

The Mansion is currently owned and operated by the Westtown Township for public meetings, community activities and private banquets. Part of the second floor of the mansion houses fulltime living quarters for the groundskeeper. A water tower of unusual architectural character is located approximately 200 feet to the southwest of the Mansion. Though the tower is no longer used for water storage, it remains as a well-preserved example of historic design and construction techniques.
